SHELTER

We provide immediate shelter through our transitional homes. We help our clients plan before they leave an abusive situation and ensure they are safe and healthy every step of the way. Our caseworkers work with our clients to find long-term sustainable housing.



FOOD & ESSENTIALS

We provide nutritious food and essentials to our clients as well as running a food program wherein food-insecure families can receive the groceries they need.



LEGAL

We offer our clients opportunities to speak to lawyers and legal aid agencies so that they may understand how to proceed with any legal issues they may be facing.



MENTAL HEALTH

Our mental health workers assess all of our clients and provide them with a number of different therapy services to ensure they are receiving help with any underlying issues.



EDUCATION & LIFE SKILLS

Through various programs, we encourage our clients to complete their education. Our caseworkers also teach life skills so that our clients are able to live independently.



EMPLOYMENT

Through resume and interview preparation and help finding employment, we help our clients secure a sustainable future for themselves and their families.



RECONCILIATION

Some clients may not face violence at home, however they need help getting through to their spouse. We offer reconciliation services, when it is safe to do so, by trained professionals.

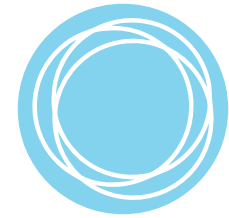
